

Complete courses

Our complete courses give you all the study resources and learning phases you need to give you the best chance of exam success. Choose from a range of courses that suits your learning style the best. You won't need to choose between separate tuition and revision phases-our courses include everything you need to know regardless of study method, to ensure you go into your exams feeling as confident as possible.

CIMA Syllabus Structure

At each Professional level there are three Objective Tests (e.g. E1, P1, F1) followed by an Integrated Case Study. You must progress by level in the order shown in the diagram to the left. To progress to the next level you must have passed all 3 Objective Tests and the Integrated Case Study from the lower level. The 3 Objective Tests within each level can be taken in any order, but must be passed before attempting the Integrated Case Study for that level.

Objective Tests (OTs)


The 9 technical exams (E1, E2, E3, P1, P2, P3, F1, F2, F3) each consist of 90 minute 'Objective Tests' taken on a computer. These are available all year around. These exams are computer marked so results will be available shortly after the exam.

Objective Tests use a combination of multiple choice, data entry, fill in the gaps and drag/drop style questions. Questions will be selected randomly and will cover all of the learning outcomes within the syllabus.

Integrated Case Study (ICS)

There is a case study at each level - Operational, Management and Strategic. These 3 hour computer exams will cover the syllabus from all 3 subjects within the level you are sitting. There are four fixed exam sittings a year - February, May, August and November. These exams are human marked and results will be available 4-5 weeks after the exam are held.

The exams will be broken down into timed sections with tasks being set based on 'trigger' information delivered at various points during the exam. The previously unseen trigger information will build on the pre-seen material that you will receive a few weeks prior to the exam. The questions will be discursive, and involve minimal calculations, short answers and essays. Some tasks will also be linked.



How to plan your studies

The first thing we would recommend you do is decide which sitting you wish to attempt your Case Study exam in and then work backwards to decide on when to sit your OT subjects.

There are a few different ways you can choose to do this.

One subject at a time

Studying 1 subject every 3 months allows you to focus on one subject at a time which you may find beneficial as you progress to the higher level subjects.

This example shows how your progress through the Management level might look like if you are ready to start it in quarter 1 of a year and want to study the level over 12 months.

Flexible study with a break

If you wished to have a bit more flexibility through the year and vary the number of subjects that you take each sitting, either to allow for peak times in work or important events in your personal life, you are still able to sit 4 exams a year but incorporate a break.

For example, you could sit two subjects in quarter 1, one in quarter 2 and Case Study in quarter 4. This would mean you are still sitting 4 exams in a year, but you have time for a summer holiday.

Fast track

If you wanted to fast track through a level then you can opt to sit more than one subject per quarter. This means you can complete the level faster to then move on to the next level.

Study at your own pace

With our OT courses starting frequently throughout the year, you can move on to the next level whenever you are ready once you have completed the previous level.

For example, if you completed your OCS exam in May and wanted to move on to the Management level straight away, then you can attend the course for your first OT in Q3 following through to the case study in the May the following year.

OT subjects can be taken in any order, however you must have passed all 3 OT subjects before you can sit your Case Study exam.

In order to ensure you retain the knowledge from your OT subjects into the Case Study, we recommend you try to study for afull level over no more than 12 months. More syllabus information can be found here.

Don't forget to book your computer based exams with us too. It is easy to book <u>online</u>. Recommended exam dates are shown on the following pages. Our results show clearly that sitting your exam in line with our recommendations gives you a 38% better chance of passing.
